


Development process for the new curriculum

The new curriculum was developed in response to many years of campaigning across Australia for one unified education system. It was developed based on a paper called the Melbourne Declaration on Educational Goals for Young Australians. Work by ACARA, the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority, was guided by this declaration as it developed the Australian Curriculum.

Many opportunities for consultation have been provided in this process across all States.

The NSW Board of Studies has incorporated the content from the Australian Curriculum in the new syllabuses it has been developing. It is planned that implementation will begin in NSW schools from January 2014. Teachers will be addressing the Australian Curriculum through its embedding in the new syllabus documents.
