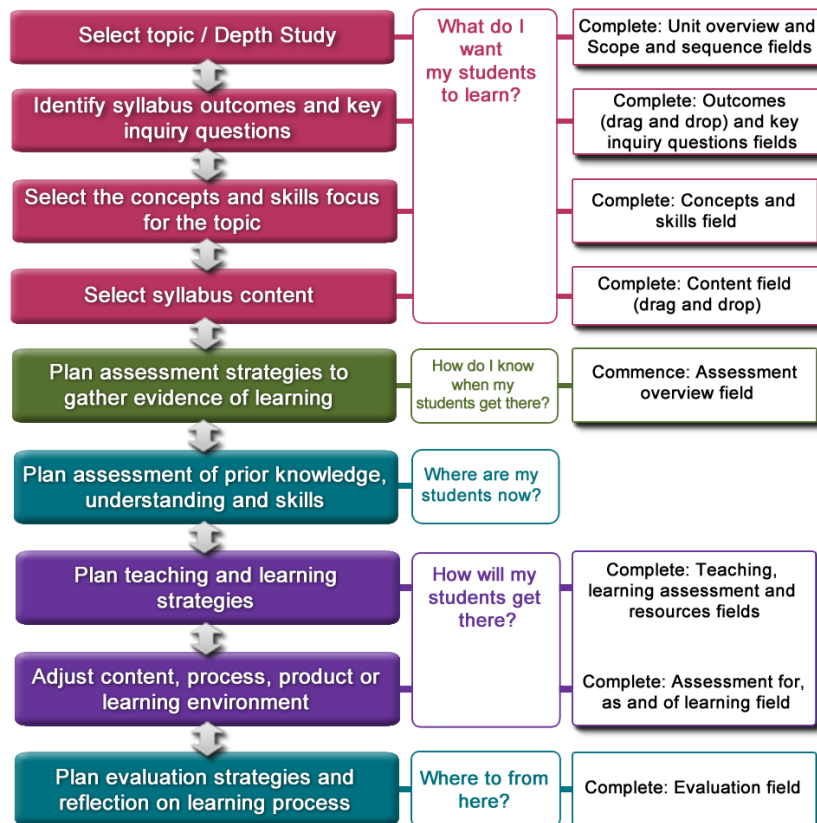


Flowchart of a learning design process
