Focus question

What was it like to 'live' at Gallipoli, according to Archie Barwick?

Talking points

In making your video clip you should address these questions and other issues:

- Describe how the men lived from day-to-day, for example, what were their dugouts like, what did they do when not fighting?
- What was the weather like, the food, flies and disease etc?
- Did Archie's tone change in his Gallipoli diary entries?

Suggested sites

<u>Archie's baptism</u> (listen to a collection of Archie Barwick's diary entries before, and in the first days of the campaign)

Archie's diary from the <u>landing on April 25</u> (start on p.99) <u>to the evacuation in December</u> (up to p.76).

Read about daily life in Gallipoli.

Further consideration

Were Archie Barwick's experiences typical of the rest of the soldiers' daily lives in Gallipoli?

Presentation ideas

The following tip(s) could be useful in your presentation:

- You are not expected to read through every entry in Archie's diary. Scan the diaries and/or search for key words such as dugouts, weather and flies.
- Acknowledge all primary and secondary sources.
