

## Differentiation strategies – Primary History example

<b>Differentiation element(s)</b>	<b>Process and Product</b>
<b>Stage</b>	Stage 2
<b>Subject</b>	History
<b>Outcomes</b>	<p><b>A student:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>describes and explains effects of British colonisation in Australia HT2-4</li> <li>applies skills of historical inquiry and communication HT2-5.</li> </ul>
<b>Content statement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>using a range of sources, investigate the everyday life of ONE of the following who sailed on the First Fleet and lived in the early colony: a soldier, a convict, ex-convict, official.</li> </ul>
<b>Purpose of lesson</b>	To identify students' skills to engage in analysis and interpretation of sources. Students will sequence historical sources to represent early settlement using maps, paintings/drawings, and the ideas of others. This will be clearly articulated as a learning goal.
<b>Strategy(ies)</b>	<p><b>Core strategies</b> Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>engage with Floorstorm* where students will analyse a range of historical sources from the time</li> <li>photograph each source using their own iPad.</li> </ul> <p><b>Differentiation strategies</b> Students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>order their own iPad images into a time sequence</li> <li>explain their reasoning to support the sequence using annotated text, audio, video and other technologies</li> <li>present their completed sequences to the class, including opportunities for peer feedback.</li> </ul> <p>*Floorstorm is the use of images to provide immediately recognisable information. Students make connections with and between the images and their own background knowledge.</p>
