

2016 Resource Allocation Model

In 2016 NSW public schools will receive the third year of additional funding made possible through the Gonski agreement.

The table below shows the average **FOEI**, 2016 RAM funding and the change from the 2015 needs based funding delivered through the RAM using methodology consistent with the recommendations of the Gonski review.

In 2016, 95 per cent of NSW public schools will receive increased RAM funding compared to their 2015 needs based allocation.
