Transcript—Beli tiket

Theme music reflecting the sounds of traditional Indonesian music, with flute, keyboard, drums and gong, over muffled conversations.

Titles: Basa basi, Beli tiket

Scene: Josh is sitting on his bed looking at his iPad. His guitar is on the floor and some books are on his desk. He receives a call on his tablet.

Josh: Halo Eddi. Apa kabar?

Eddi is sitting on a sofa. He is also holding a tablet.

Eddi: Oh, halo Josh. Saya baik-baik saja. Kamu sedang apa?

Josh: Saya sedang membaca di internet. Ada pertandingan kriket yang penting akhir Januari.

Eddi: Di mana?

Josh: Lokasinya di Olympic Park.

Eddi: Siapa bermain?

Josh: Australia lawan Inggris. Eddi mau ikut nonton?

Eddi: Ya. Siapa lagi mau ikut?

Josh: Kakak laki-laki saya, Ben.

Eddi: Tanggal berapa pertandingannya? Jam berapa?

Josh: Tanggal 26 Januari. Mulai jam sebelas.

Eddi: Itu Hari Australia, bukan?

Josh: Ya benar.

Eddi: Berapa harga tiketnya?

Josh: Tiket sedikit mahal, 90 dolar.

Eddi: Ya ... betul ... mahal sekali. Sebenarnya sih saya pulang ke Indonesia pada tanggal 30 Januari.... tapi saya belum menyaksikan pertandingan seperti itu.

Josh: Ini pasti pengalaman yang menarik.

Eddi: Bagaimana kita beli tiketnya?

Josh: Di internet.

Eddi: Bagaimana kita ke sana? Naik kereta api atau naik bis?

Josh: Saya pikir lebih baik naik kereta api, karena lebih cepat daripada bis. Pasti ramai sekali ya.

Eddi: Jauh dari rumahmu? Kita harus berangkat jam berapa?

Josh: Tidak begitu jauh dari rumah. Kita bertemu di setasiun pada jam sembilan.

Eddi: OK. Makasih ya Josh. Sampai ketemu.

Josh: Sampai jumpa!

Eddi: Kakakmu di mana?

Eddi: Ya ... Kamu bawa tiketnya?

Josh: Tiket? Saya? Saya pikir kamu yang membelinya?

Eddi: Masa, saya pikir kamu yang membelinya.
