

Basa basi

Transcript—Suka pizza?

Theme music reflecting the sounds of traditional Indonesian music, with flute, keyboard, drums and gong, over muffled conversations.

Titles: Basa basi, Suka pizza?

Scene: In a lounge room. Two girls, Melissa and Endah, are sitting on a green sofa talking to each other. In front of them is a table covered with a cloth. A newspaper, a brochure and a phone are on the table. Endah is wearing a blue headscarf, a red long-sleeved top and blue jeans. Melissa is wearing a pale short-sleeved top and blue jeans. Both are wearing joggers.

Melissa: Saya lapar sekali. Endah, apakah kamu lapar?

Endah: Lapar? Nanti kan ibumu membawa sate ayam buat makan malam bukan?

Melissa: Ya, tapi saya begitu lapar saya bisa makan malam dua kali. Kamu suka pizza?

Endah: Ya, saya sangat suka pizza.

Melissa: Ayo kita memesannya. Ibu tidak akan tahu. Apalagi pengantarnya lucu.

Endah: Benar? Bagaimana dia?

Melissa: Ya, dia ganteng sekali. Rambutnya berwarna coklat dan matanya biru.

Endah: Namanya siapa?

Melissa: Namanya James. Dan dia bisa berbicara bahasa Indonesia!

Endah: Hebat ya! Dia bisa bahasa Indonesia! Saya tidak sabar ingin bertemu sama dia.

Melissa: Ayo kita memesannya sebelum ibu pulang.

Melissa picks up brochure from pizza shop and the girls look at it.

Melissa: Ada banyak pilihan! Kamu mau pizza apa?

Endah: Mmm, semuanya kelihatan enak.

Endah points to one of the pizzas in the brochure.

Endah: Pizza Meat Lovers ini kelihatan menarik. Ada keju, ham, ayam dan sosis.

Melissa: Kamu mau coba?

Endah: Ya, saya mau cari yang halal.

- Melissa: Oh ya. Kamu suka sayur?
- Endah: Saya tidak suka sayur di pizza. Saya mau pesan pizza dengan ayam, daging sapi dan keju. Yang kecil saja. Dan kamu?
- Melissa: Saya suka sayur. Saya mau pesan pizza supreme yang besar dengan keju, ham, jamur, cabai besar, bawang, buah zaitun, nanas dan bawang putih.
- Endah: Wah, kamu benar-benar lapar ya! Hati-hati ya. Jangan makan terlalu banyak!
- Melissa: Mau minum apa?
- Endah: Air putih saja.
- Melissa: Saya mau jus apel.
- Endah: Berapa harga semuanya? Mahal?
- Melissa: Tidak begitu mahal, cuma tiga puluh dolar.

Endah takes money from wallet and hands it to Melissa.

- Endah: Ini uangnya.

- Melissa: Terima kasih.

*Melissa picks up her phone and dials number. Rhythmic music plays in the background.
The phone rings. Someone on the other end answers, 'Hello?'*

- Melissa: OK, nama: Melissa. Alamat: Jalan King nomor dua puluh tujuh . Nomor HP: 0016230001 ...

- Endah: Saya tidak sabar ingin bertemu sama James!

Finger on door bell followed by sound of bell.

- Melissa: Nah ... ini dia! Pizzanya datang!

Both girls rush to the door and Melissa calls out.

- Melissa: Jamessss...

Girls open door and look very surprised.

- Delivery man: Your pizzas.

The girls take the pizzas and thank the delivery man. They look a little disappointed.

Door closes.

The girls are sitting back on the sofa. One box is empty and the other has one remaining slice of pizza. Melissa rubs her stomach.

Melissa: Ah, pizzanya habis. Saya kenyang sekali.

Endah rubs her stomach gently.

Endah: Saya juga. Saya kenyang dan perut saya terasa sedikit sakit.

Both girls turn and look at the door. Melissa's mother enters carrying two boxes. She looks down and sees the empty boxes on the table.

Melissa: Pizza??

Mother: The satay were all gone.

Both girls moan.

Girls: Aduh!!
