- Established in 2005
- Over 1,500 students
- Over 100 staff
- Located in North-West Sydney
- 2% indigenous enrolments
- 54% Language background other than English
- PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning) School
- Dedicated Support Unit (30 students)

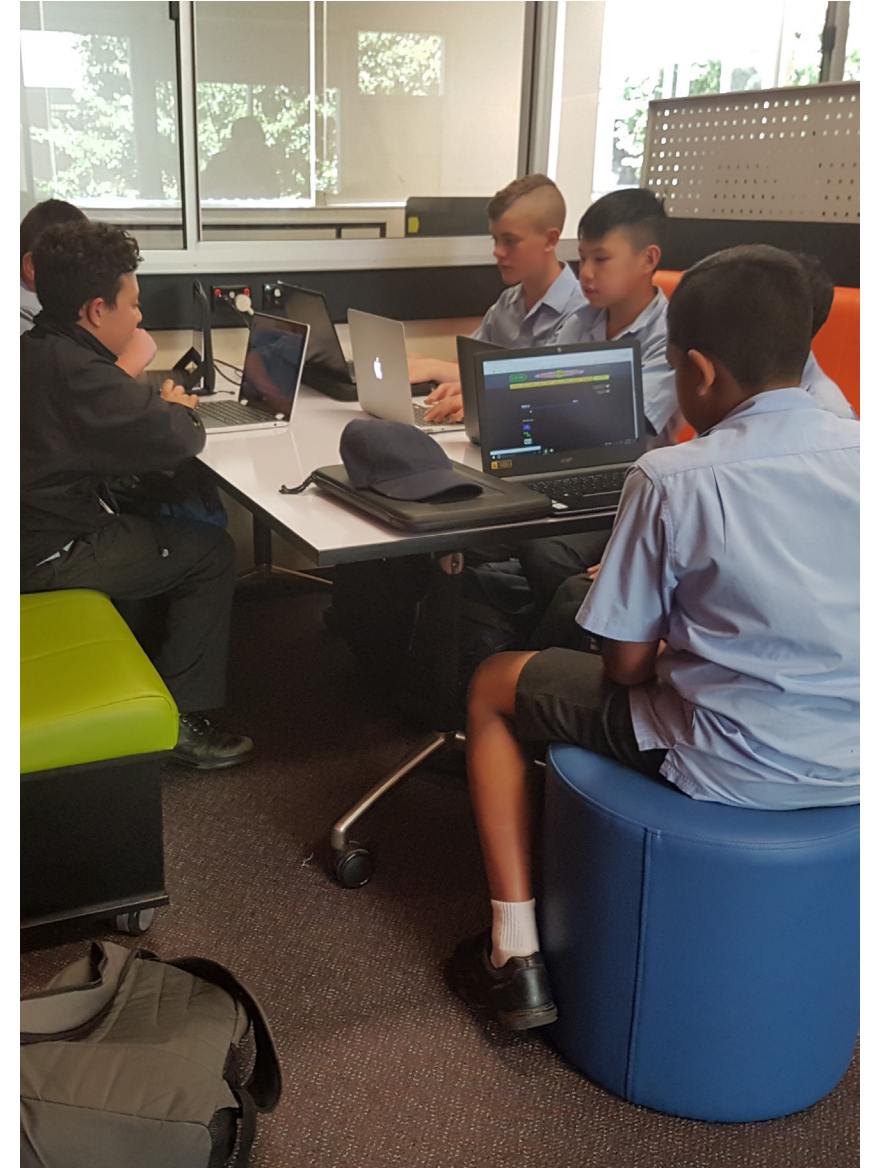

- Open every recess and lunch to students (as well as after school)



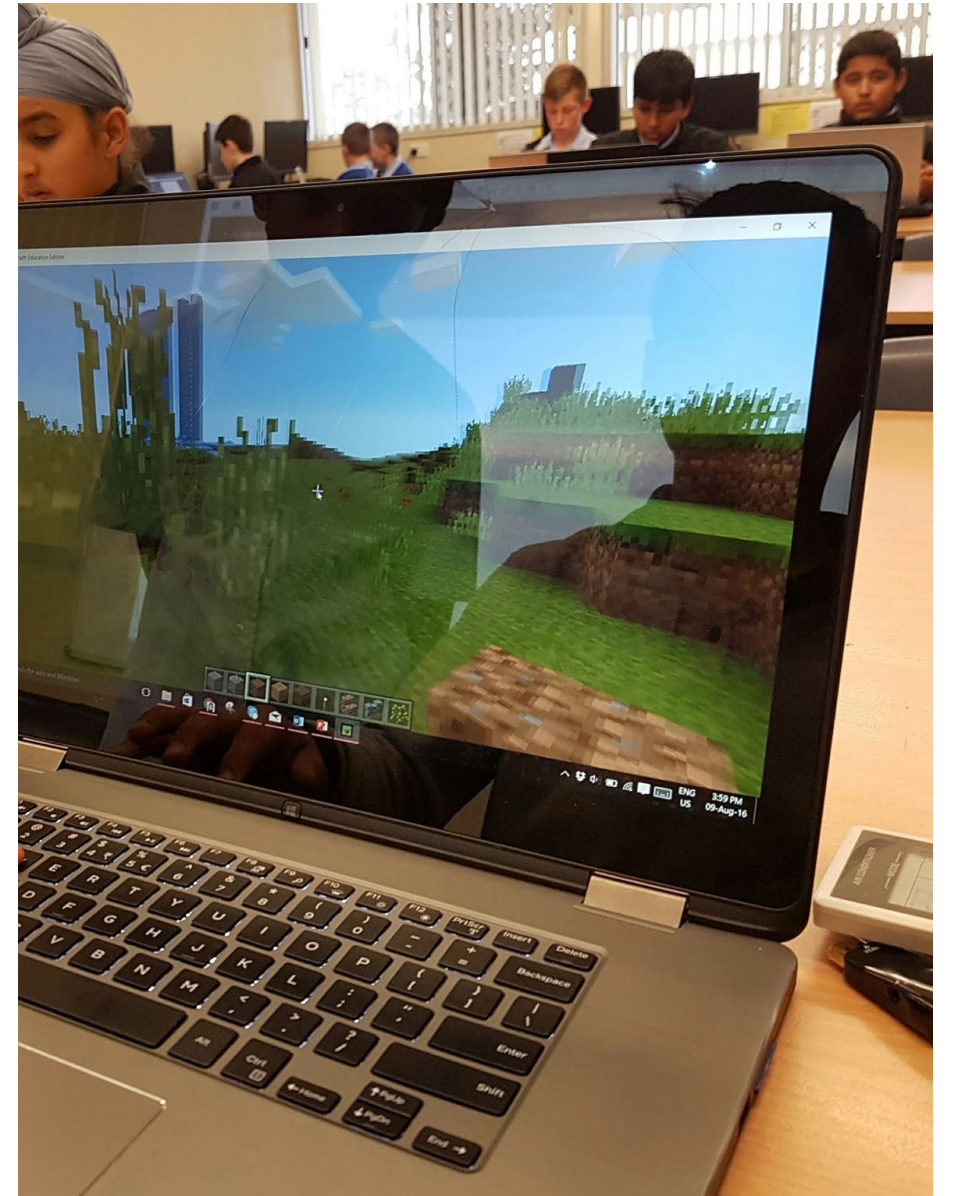
Film, TV, Radio & Social Media
